Science and Maths

Go on a magnetic treasure hunt in your house. How many magnetic objects can you find? What materials are they made out of?

Investigate the best surfaces at home for toy cars to travel on: carpet or a tiled floor? Measure the distance travelled on each type of surface and rank each one in order of effectiveness. Make a table or bar chart to show your results.



English

It is believed that the **wheel** was invented in the Bronze Age. Write an explanation to show how this changed people's lives.

Make anagrams using some of the topic spellings – can you get a friend to solve them?

History

Compare the tools humans had in the Stone, Bronze and Iron Age. Present this however you would like.

Research the different types of houses that people lived in in the Bronze Age and Iron Age. Compare this to what we know about Stone Age homes, decide which you think is the best and give your reasons why.
