

Cook a traditional meal from one (or all) of the countries that make up the British Isles. Take photos, write out recipe cards or review the meal(s) explaining what you liked about it/them.

Can you find out what England, Scotland, Wales and Ireland are most famous for?



Create a map of the British Isles showing all the cities/towns you have visited. Remember to explain who you have visited or why you went to each place!

Find out some facts about the British Isles; How did it get its name? Who is in charge of it? How many people live in the British Isles? What languages are spoken? Etc.

Re-enact a famous battle that took place in the British Isles. Who won? Who lost?

Find out about 3 famous people from the British Isles and create fact files about them.
